While her recent carpool arrangement has been going for about three years, Marielena has actually been carpooling for about 15 years. "It's convenient, so why not?"

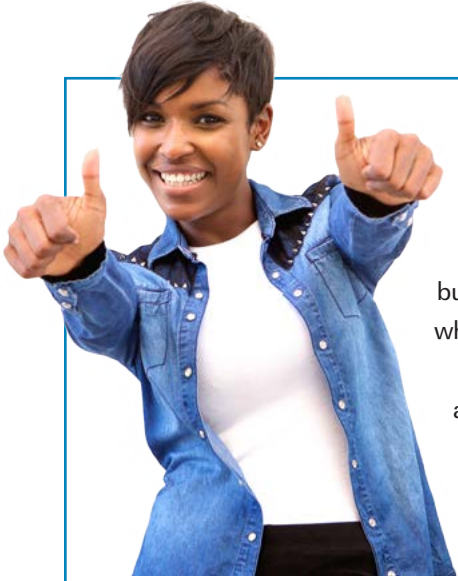


Need New Commute Options?

Ride Free to Popular OC Attractions

Enjoy all that summer has to offer without the hassle of driving and parking. Summer trolleys in Orange County provide free rides to many of your favorite destinations, including beaches, shopping, special events and more.

Schedules vary, and most trolleys operate through Sept. 5. Trolleys currently making the rounds:

- **Laguna Beach**—Trolleys include the Canyon Route (daily) and Coastal Route (daily) and the Summer Breeze (Saturdays/Sundays).
- **San Clemente**—Running daily, the trolley covers two routes: a Downtown Red Line and a North San Clemente Blue Line.
- **Dana Point**—Daily service to shopping, beaches, major hotels, the harbor and more.
- **San Juan Capistrano**—Runs weekends with special event trolley

service to the City's "San Juan Summer Nites" concert series at HTC Park on Aug. 18 and Sept. 15.

- **Balboa Peninsula Trolley**—Runs Saturdays and Sundays with 22 stops, including the Newport Pier and Balboa Village & Fun Zone.

The Rideshare Office can help by providing you with an updated RideGuide.

A RideGuide gives you all your commute options based on where you live, work and your work schedule. It includes potential carpool partners, vanpools, bus/rail routing, Park & Ride lot locations and more.

If you want to get one, complete the **OC Rideshare Sign-Up Form** and check the first box for a matchlist (RideGuide).

Then scan and email the form to **rideshare@ocgov.com**. The Rideshare Office will generate a personalized RideGuide and email it to you.

Another option: You can go to Southern California's rideshare site, **ridematch.info** and create a profile. You'll get a RideGuide instantly generated online.
