"Why I Rideshare"

While he currently often telecommutes, Andrew Bennett rides Metrolink on the days he goes into the office—from Riverside to Santa Ana, where he works for the County Health Care Agency.

One of the main reasons he chooses the train is to avoid traffic on the 91 Freeway. "If you're lucky, the drive will take an hour, but if there's a car accident, it can take two and a half hours or more," he says.

Not only does he typically get home to his family faster, but he has more energy to enjoy the evening with his young son. "When I drive, I find myself extremely tired," Andrew says. "Taking Metrolink, I have a lot more energy to play with him when I get home."



Save On Metrolink Monthly Passes

October marks Metrolink's 30th anniversary. To celebrate, they'll be offering riders a 30% discount on monthly passes throughout October, November and December.

You can save even more when you **purchase your pass via payroll deduction.**

This allows you to pay transit fares using pre-tax dollars, which will lower your overall taxable income.

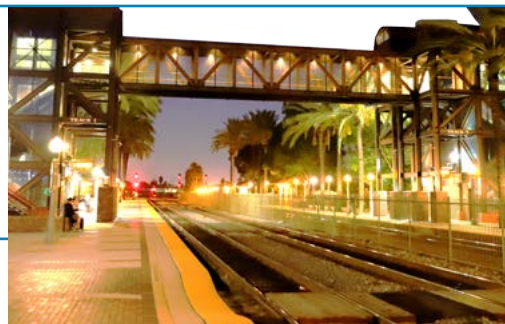
Riverside/San Bernardino Counties
