WAIVE YOUR COUNTY COVERAGE

Waiving your county health coverage is an active election offered during Open Enrollment.

After your election, a waive coverage attestation needs to be completed either through the My OC Benefits portal or on the phone with a benefits service representative.

ALREADY WAIVED COVERAGE?

If you would like to remain on waived coverage, you will not need to submit annual attestations.

COMPLETE THE ATTESTATION BY YOUR DEADLINE!

Failure to complete this process by your deadline will default you into the coverage you had prior to your 2025 Open Enrollment elections.

DO YOU HAVE COUNTY COVERAGE, AND COVERAGE THROUGH A SPOUSE/DOMESTIC PARTNER?

County coverage is primary for employees. When you get a medical bill, your County coverage pays first. That means you have to satisfy any requirements under your County plan before your bill gets paid (for example, you have to pay any applicable deductible, copay, etc.).

Coverage through a spouse/domestic partner is secondary. After your County medical plan pays your claim, only then can it get submitted to your secondary coverage.

Having two plans does NOT mean you get twice the benefits.
